# Todd Telander: Bringing Atmosphere to Landscape Painting 

## Supply List

Oil paint (any artist's quality paint-not student grade)
Yellow Light or Lemon Yellow
Yellow Ochre
Burnt Sienna
Alizarin Crimson
Paynes Gray
Ultramarine Blue
Titanium White

Odorless thinner and container
Painting medium of your choice (I like Liquin or Galkyd)
Bristle brushes (filbert, sizes 1,2 4,6,8)
Two canvases or panels (I suggest $9 \times 12$ " or $11 \times 14$ ")
Any size sketchbook for working out composition and taking notes
Pen or pencil
Palette
Palette knife
Paper towels or rags
Paint box or table easel. We will be working indoors. (If you have a plein air setup you can use that if you like)

Three or four high quality photos/prints of a landscape you would like to paint. Working from an image on your phone is inadequate, but a laptop or ipad would work fine. We will choose one image to focus on for class. I highly recommend photos that you took yourself of a place you have seen with your own eyes. Also helpful is a scene that shows definite foreground, middle ground, and background.
